FAFSA Overview



2024-25 FAFSA Opened 12/31/2023



Department of Education (DE) errors in the tables delayed processing



DE slated to start processing FAFSAs in early March



It will take schools at least 2 weeks to test data and begin to issue award notices



April is the earliest award notices could start to flow

School of Medicine Scholarships

– Fleur de Lis and Magis Service Award

- First Round of Awards will be announced on January 15, 2024*+.
Deadline for consideration is December 31, 2023.
- Second Round of Awards will be announced on March 22, 2024+.
Deadline for consideration is March 8, 2024.

– Cura Personalis Scholarship

- All awards will be announced March 22, 2024 (contingent on FAFSA).
Deadline for consideration is March 8, 2024

If you are not selected for the first round of awards, you will remain eligible for the second round without having to reapply

You will remain on the alternate list for the scholarship indefinitely.

Should an initial awardee decline, the next eligible candidate will receive the scholarship

– Diversity Scholarships and Lo Family Scholarship

- Application link became available in November.
- Applicants will be notified on a rolling basis if they have been awarded a scholarship

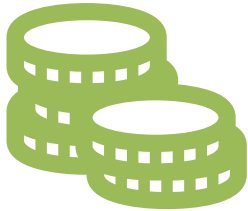

Loan Eligibility

- COA = \$ 94,924
- Scholarship - \$ 30,000
- Unsubsidized Loan - \$ 40,500*
- Graduate PLUS Loan = \$ 24,424*

* Loan amounts will be larger to include loan fees in order to net the amounts referenced



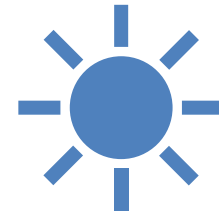

Aid for Living Expenses

- Direct Semester Cost \$ 35,362
- Scholarship - 15,000
- Net Unsubsidized Loan - 20,250
- Net Grad PLUS Loan - 12,212
- Anticipated Refund \$ 12,100

- August – December (Monthly Est.) \$ 2,420

(Monthly Estimate for Living Expenses – You can anticipate the same for Spring)

Loans for Disadvantaged Students (LDS)

Eligibility Requirements

Must come from a disadvantaged background

Be a U.S. citizen

5% interest rate

Interest does not accrue until repayment begins

12-month grace period

Unlimited residency deferment

10-25 year repayment period

Applications available after August 1st,
in Student Financial Services or online

October 6, 2024 - priority date to submit LDS application

August 1

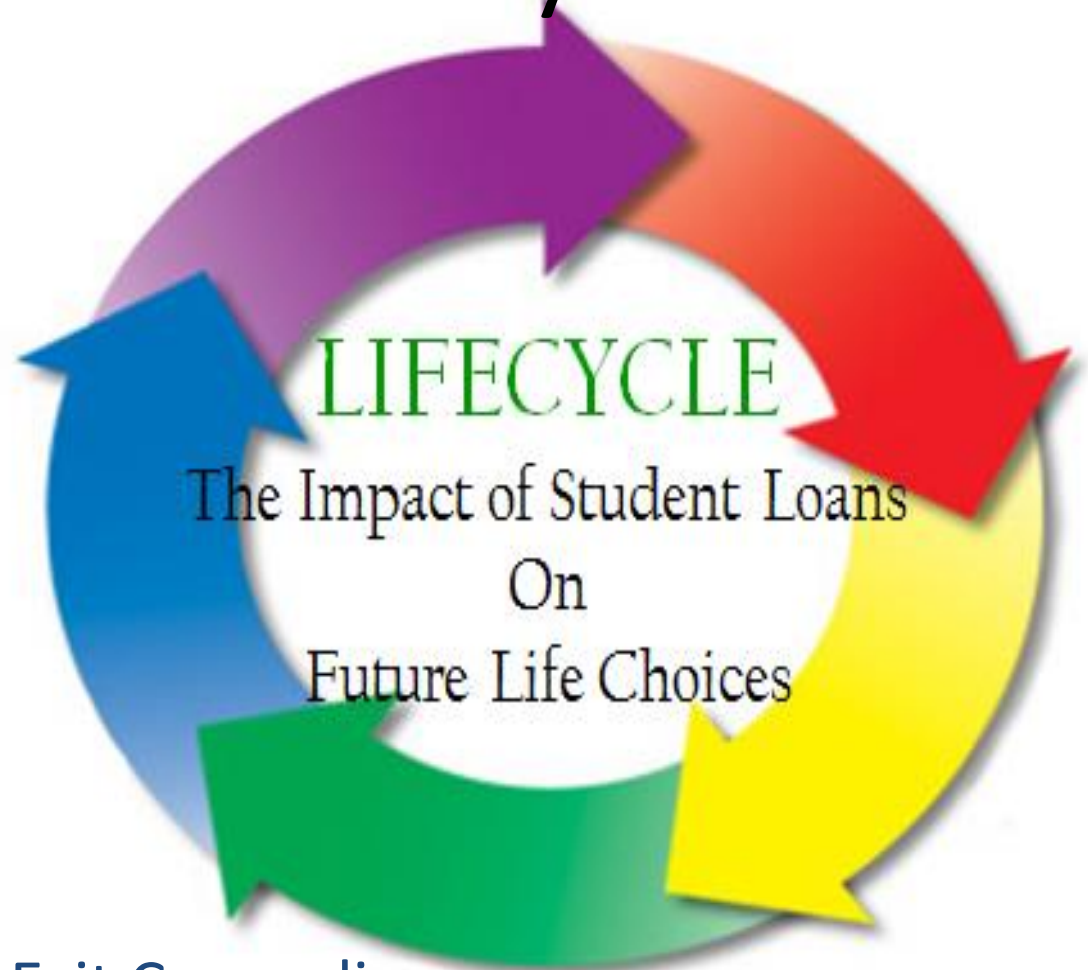
Fall Semester payment due
